Note: Practicum hours: The national standard for graduates of DNP programs is 1000 clinical hours. These include all clinical hours transferred in from your MSN NP or advanced practice specialty program. Each student will be advised as to the number of clinical hours necessary to complete the DNP program requirements. Students whose MSN advanced practice programs exceed the 1000 hours will still be required to complete a minimum of DNP practicum and capstone project hours. The number of hours will be determined in consultation with the student's advisor and the Director of the DNP program.
