**Title**

Violence Prevention and Application of a Campus Assessment Plan

**Abstract**

This project sets out to investigate the characteristics and behaviors associated with violence on an urban, public, minority serving, Midwestern, university campus. This capstone project provides a response to concerns related to violence through the use of a campus violence response survey and referrals of violent observations to a multidisciplinary campus assessment team (CAT). The evaluation of measurement tools for aggression and violence potential will provide the team and clinicians essential data needed for proper referral to trained specialists. The role of the APN in campus violence prevention is discussed. Additional outcomes from survey findings include heightened awareness related to violence and application of marketing strategies to increase violence prevention.
