The Center for Nursing Classification & Clinical Effectiveness at the University of Iowa, College of Nursing, will host the 9th Institute on Nursing Informatics and Classification on June 9-11, 2010. This conference focuses on nursing informatics and use of standardized nursing languages in clinical practice, research, and educational settings. The Center is accepting abstracts for paper or poster presentations. Please consider submitting an abstract.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION FOR PAPER OR POSTER PRESENTATION

1. All abstracts must include a cover sheet with the following information:
 - Title of presentation
 - Lead presenter's name, credentials, e-mail address, mailing address (street, city, state/province, zip code, country), telephone and fax numbers and affiliation
 - Name(s), credentials and affiliation of co-presenter(s)
2. Please specify preference of oral presentation or poster presentation.
3. Indicate a focus area for the submission:
Informatics, Education, Practice, Administration, Research
4. Submit the abstract electronically to **classification-center@uiowa.edu**
 - All abstracts must be submitted in English
 - Abstract text must not exceed 400 words
 - Please create a new document and title it: SummerInstitute_(your last name).doc for example SummerInstitute_Johnson.doc

PRESENTATIONS

Papers

Paper presentations are 25 minutes in length. Within this time limit presenters should reserve two minutes for introductions and 5-10 minutes for a question and answer section. A microphone, LCD Projector, and a computer will be provided. If you need any other items please include this in your abstract submission. Electronic submission of the presentation will be due in mid May.

Posters

No audiovisual equipment will be available for poster presentations. Illustrations and text must be legible from a distance. Poster viewing should be sequential, with arrows, letters or numbers so it is self-explanatory. Handouts are optional and are the responsibility of the presenter. Specific guidelines will be provided with acceptance letter.

NOTIFICATION OF ACCEPTANCE

A notification email of papers and posters selected by the review committee will be sent to the lead presenter by the end of the year with speaker/poster information. This will include instructions and deadlines for completing necessary biographical and other forms.

All presenters are required to register for the full conference. Presenters will receive a discount off the conference registration fee (full-conference registration only; this discount is available for one presenter per paper or poster).
